

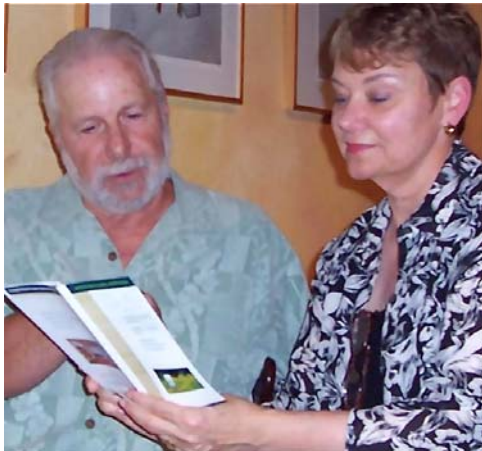
## RICK MOZER, RLM CONSTRUCTION SERVICES:
